\$20 Street Food Crawl Through San Francisco

A self-guided street food adventure through SF's tastiest neighborhoods.

Stop 1 – Mission District: Tacos + Burritos

- La Taqueria (2889 Mission St.) – Taco \$4.50 or split burrito ~\$10
 - El Farolito (2779 Mission St.) – Super Taco ~\$5
- Budget so far: ~\$5–10

Stop 2 – The Ferry Building: Farmers Market Snacks

- Acme Bread Company – Baguette slice + cheese sample ~\$3–4
 - El Porteño Empanadas – Empanada ~\$5
- Budget so far: ~\$10–15

Stop 3 – Chinatown: Savory + Sweet

- Golden Gate Bakery – Egg Custard Tart ~\$3
 - Good Mong Kok Bakery – Dumplings (3 pcs) ~\$5
- Budget so far: ~\$15–18

Stop 4 – North Beach: Italian Street Treats

- Liguria Bakery – Focaccia slice ~\$2–3
- Budget so far: ~\$18–20

Optional Bonus Stops

- Off the Grid Food Truck Events – Small bites ~\$5–8
- Richmond District Asian Snacks – Bubble tea or pork bun ~\$4–5

Suggested Itinerary Flow

1. Start in Mission District – tacos + burrito tastes.
2. Take BART/Muni to Embarcadero – Ferry Building snacks.
3. Walk or take Muni to Chinatown – dumplings + egg tarts.
4. End in North Beach – focaccia snack + evening vibes.

Pro Tips

- Cash is king at many SF street food spots.
- Split plates with a friend to stretch your \$20.
- Weekends = best street food variety.
- Walk between neighborhoods if possible – it's part of the experience!
